

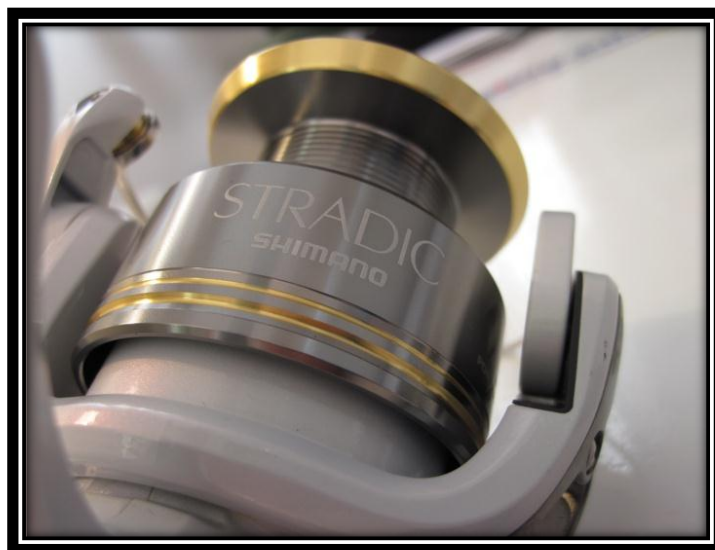

Remove the Handle

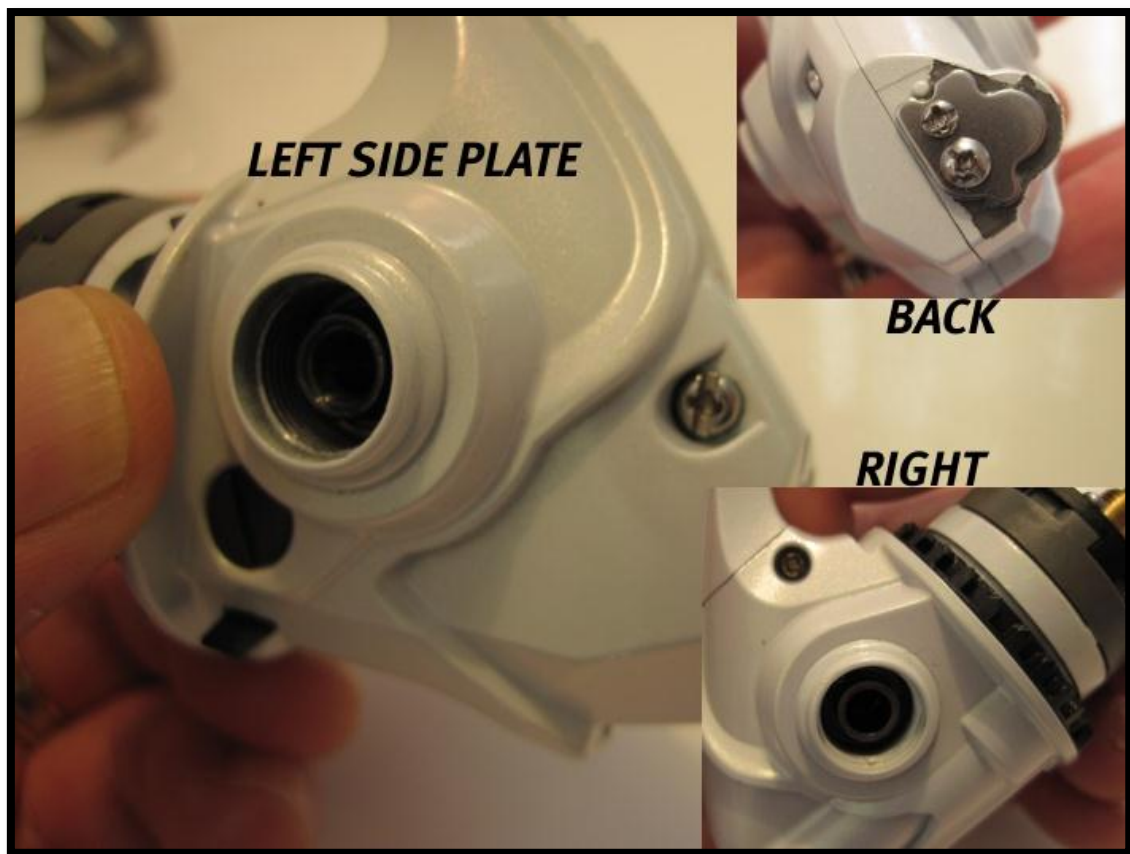
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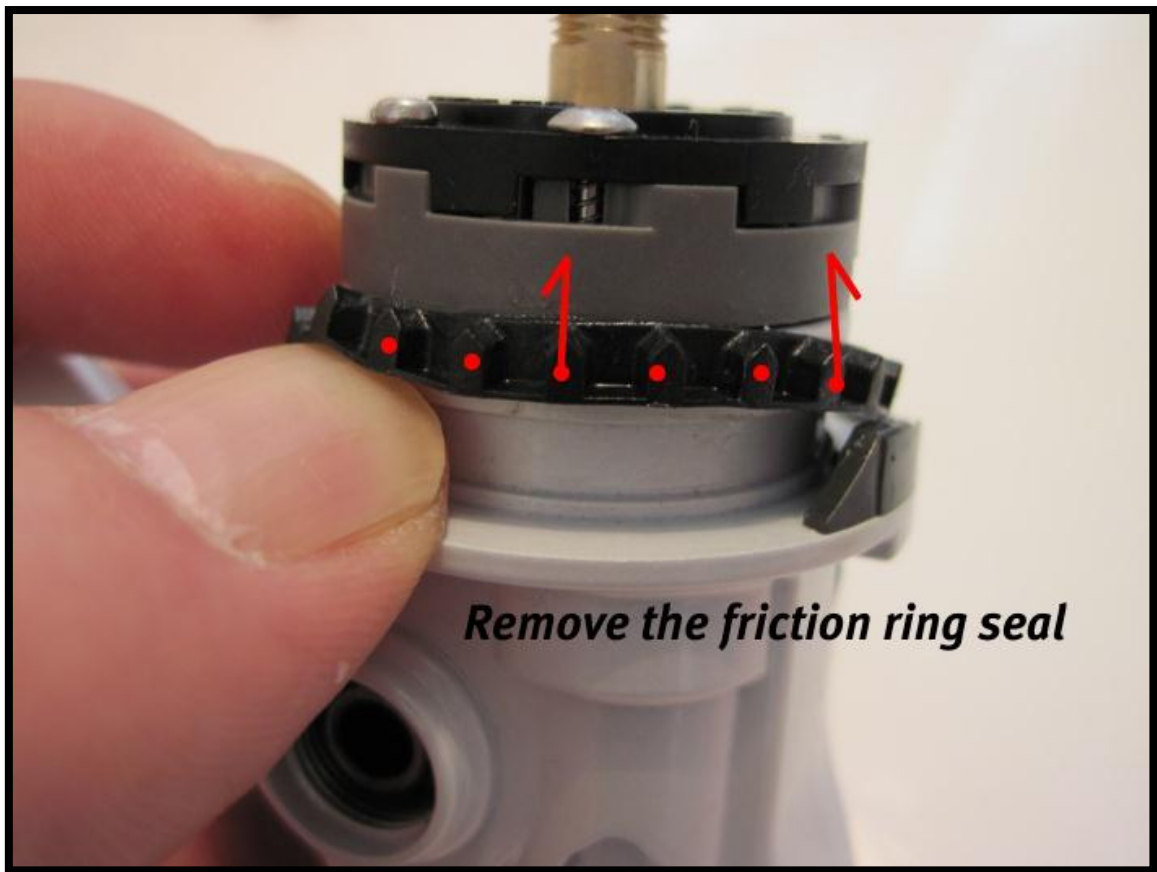
Start off by removing the Handle

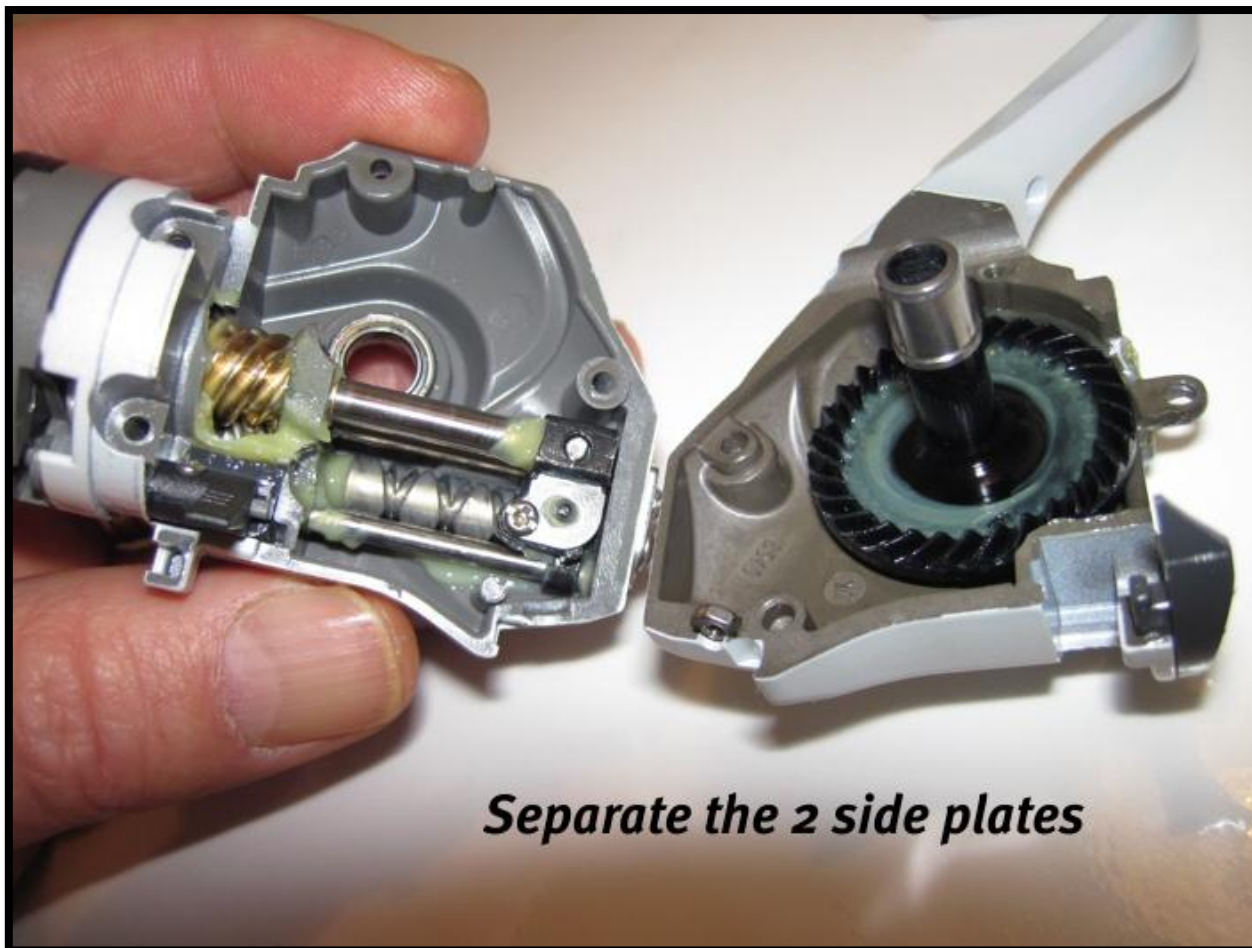




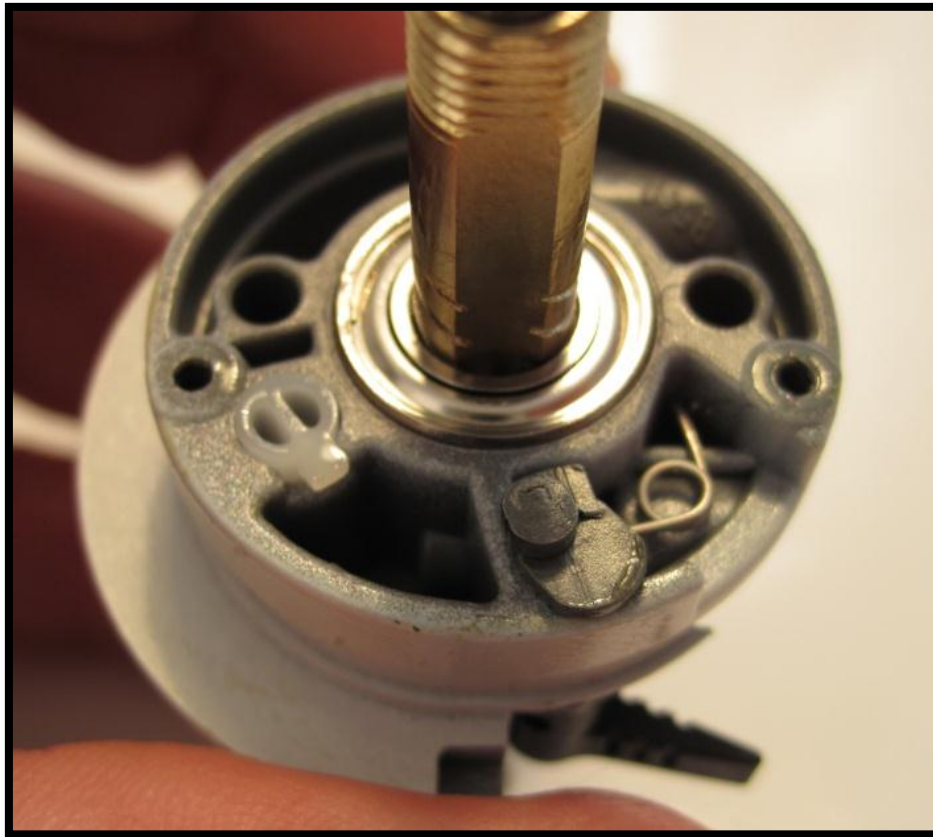




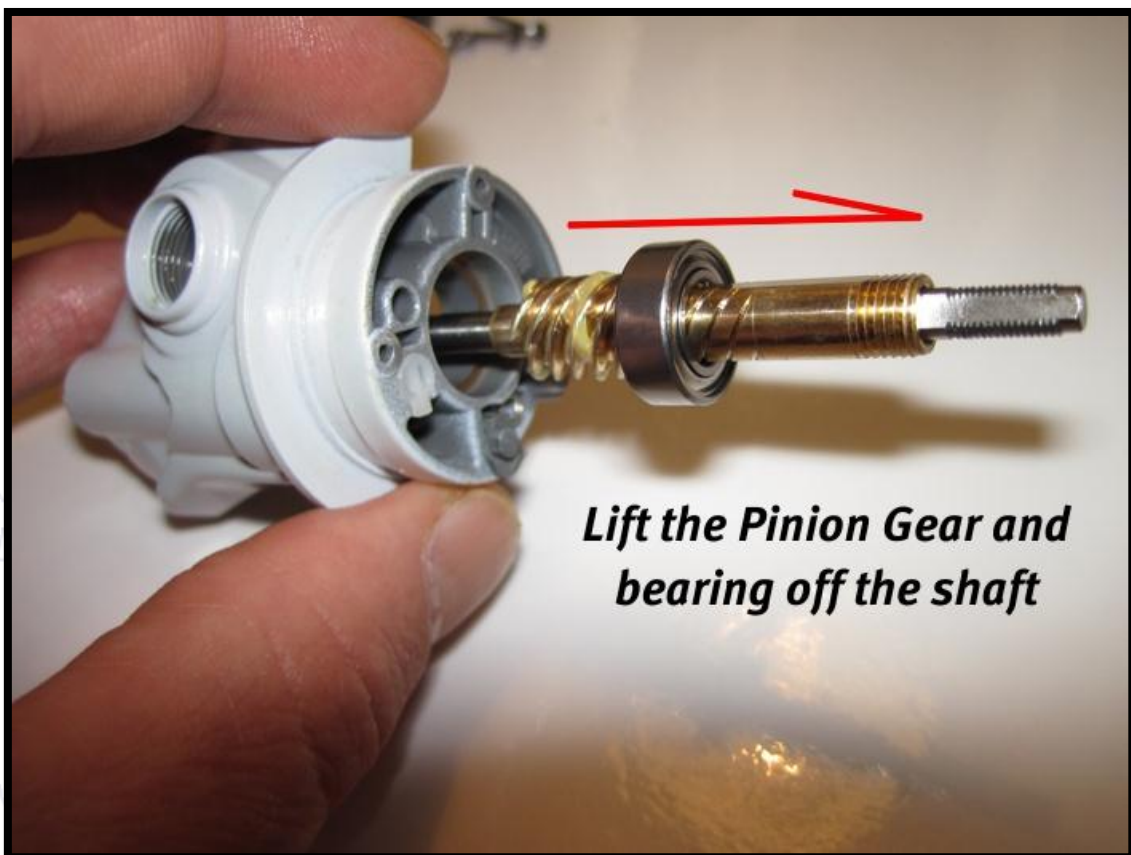


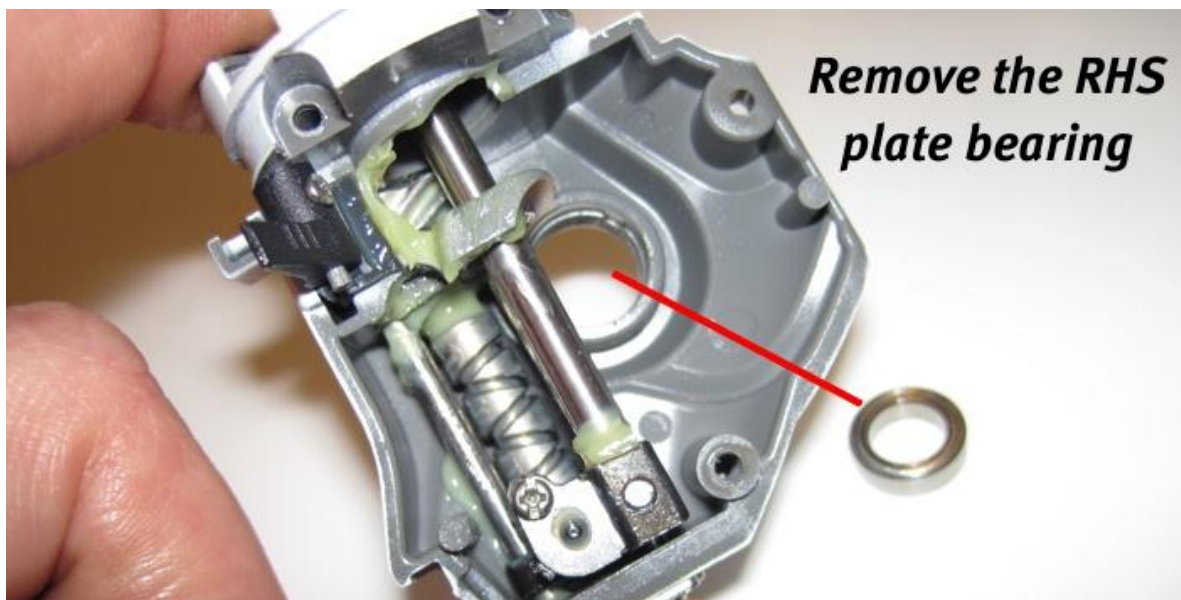


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This is what the reel looks like having removed the Anti-reverse bearing





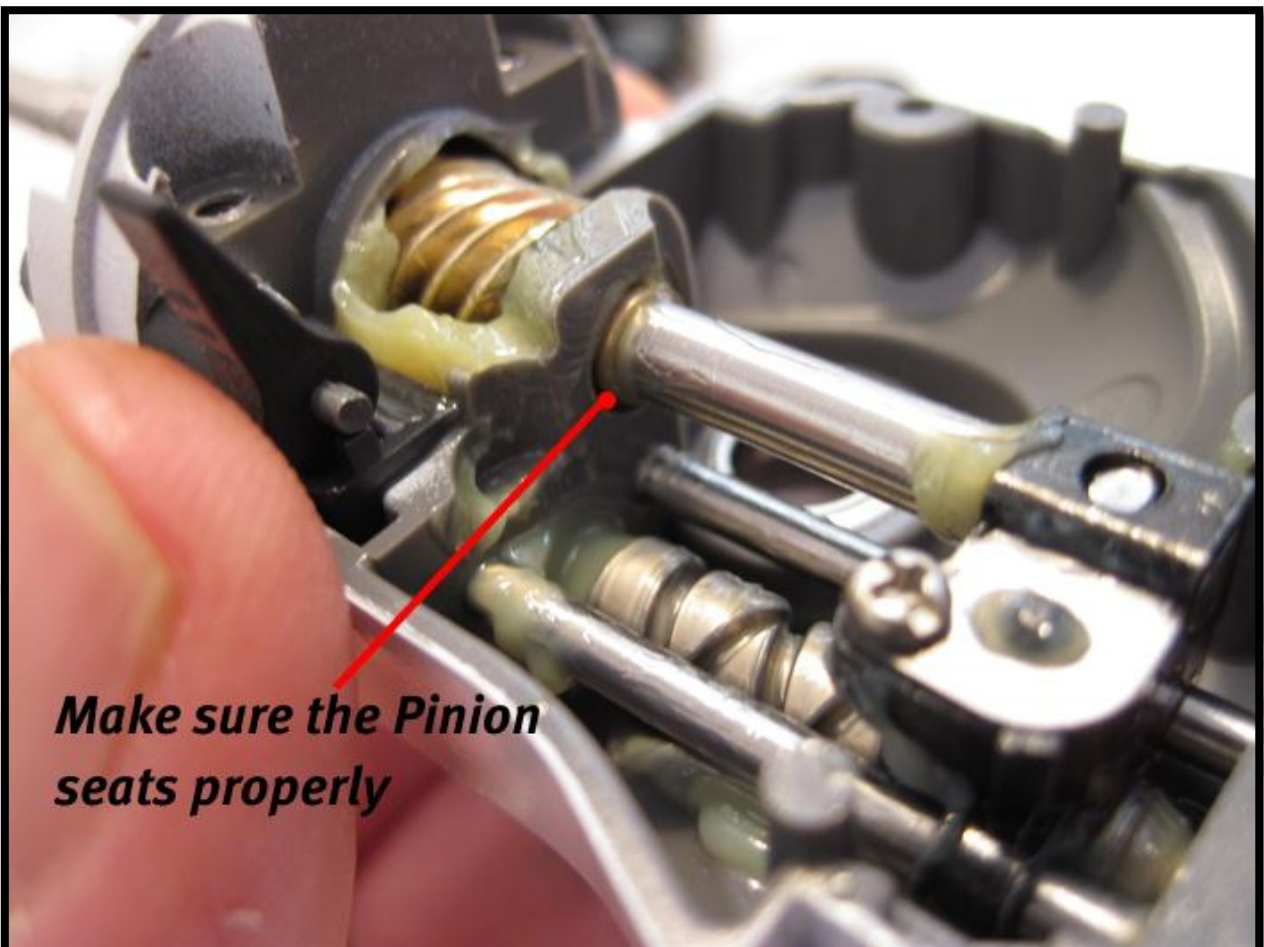
***This is as far as you should go for a standard service
The worm gears and drive shaft can be left in place,
scrubbed with a toothbrush and benzine; and then
regreased thoroughly.***



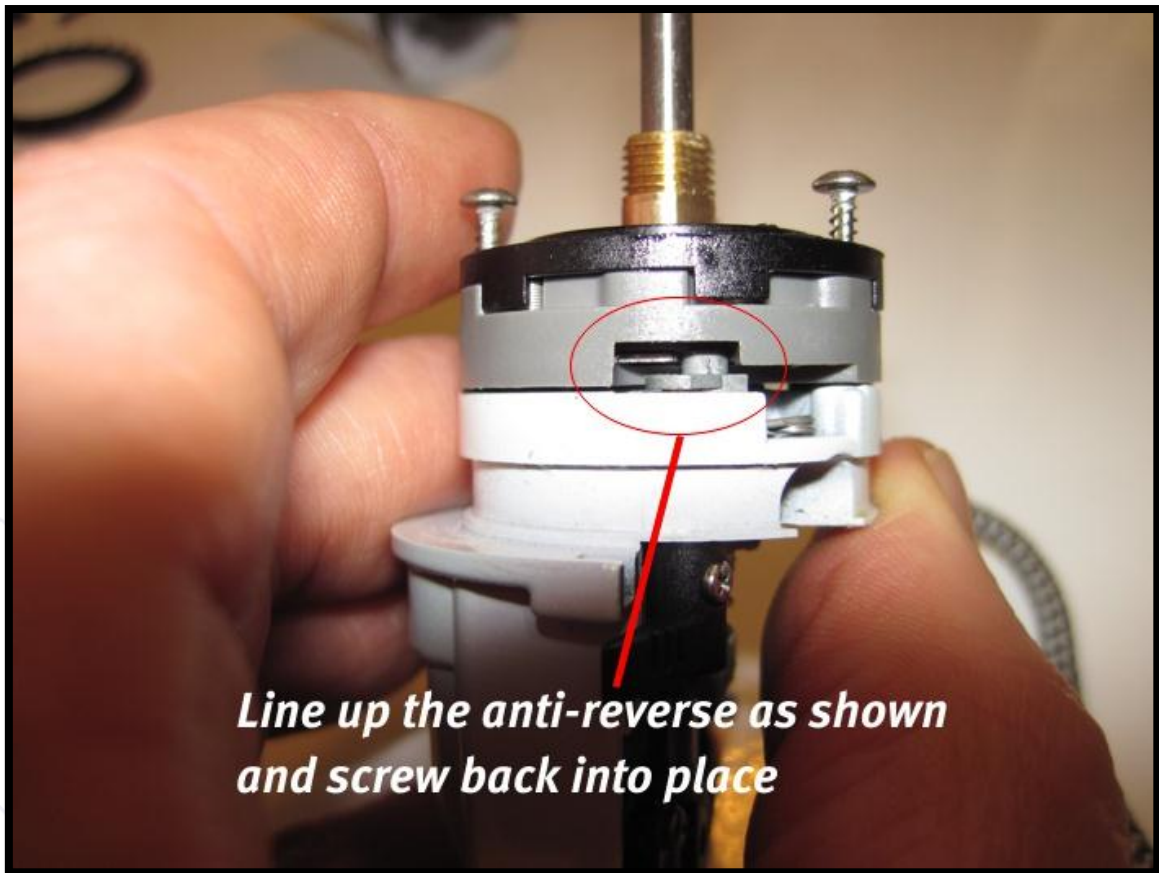


Relube bearing, grease the gear and replace

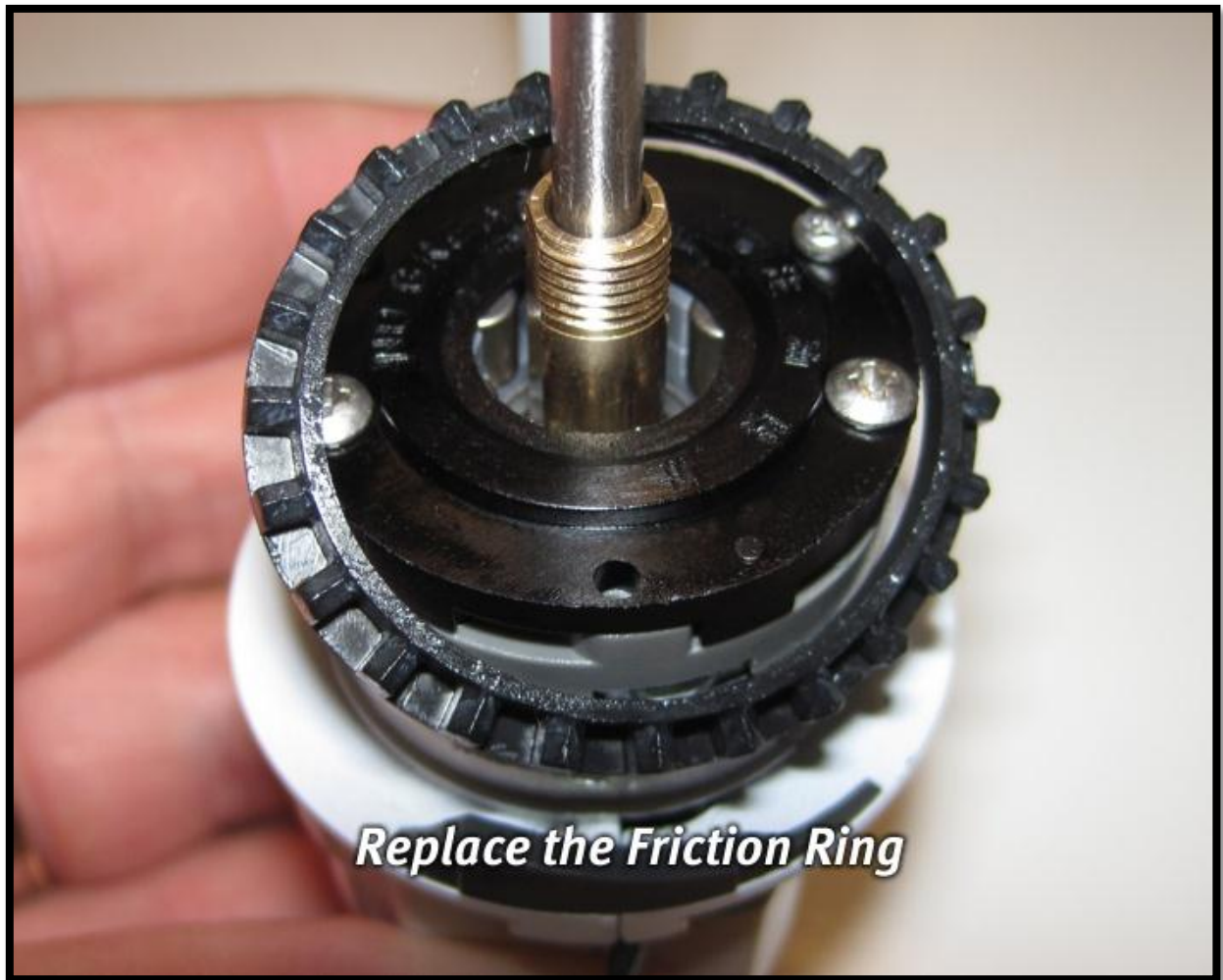




Underside of the Anti-reverse bearing



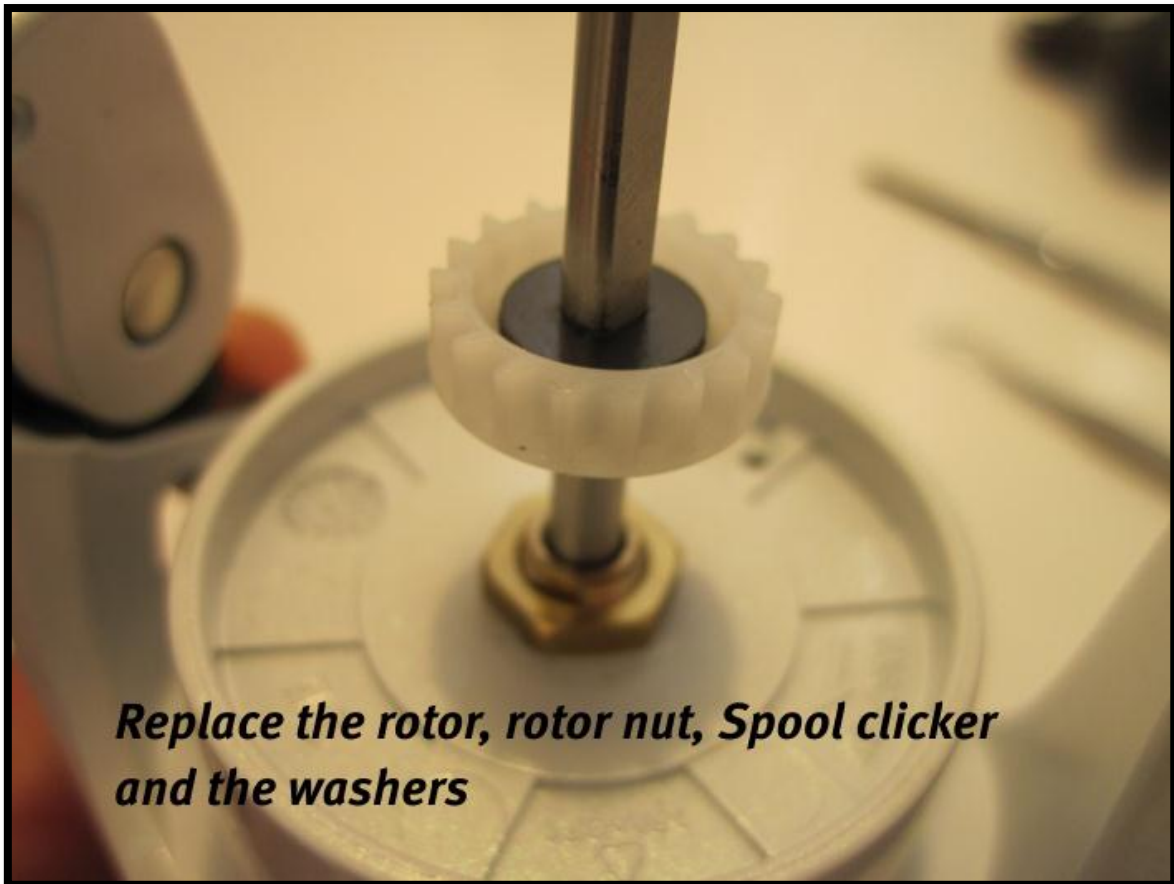




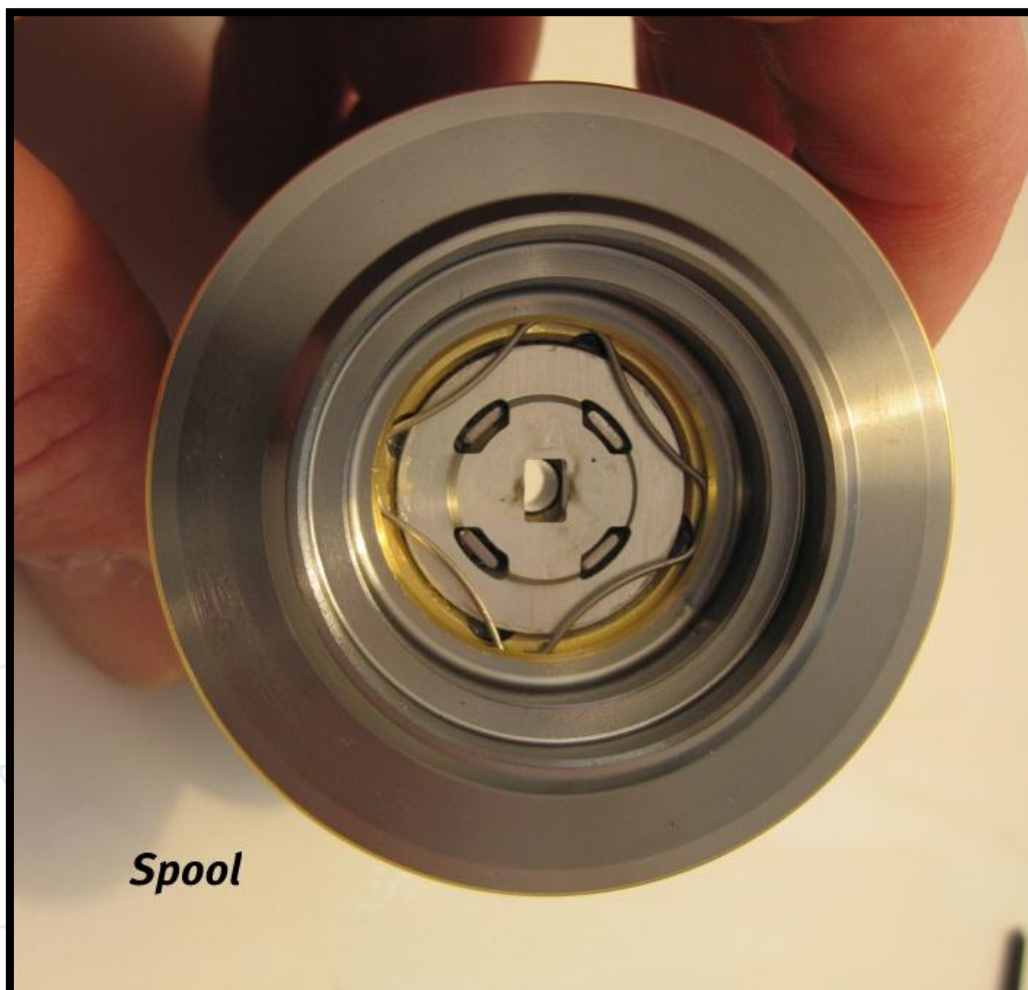


*Replace the side

Inspect them, clean, regrease lightly with Cal's or a Teflon based grease and re-assemble.

That should keep your reel as smooth as new for the next few sessions!

All bearings should be oiled, Gears and working parts greased.
